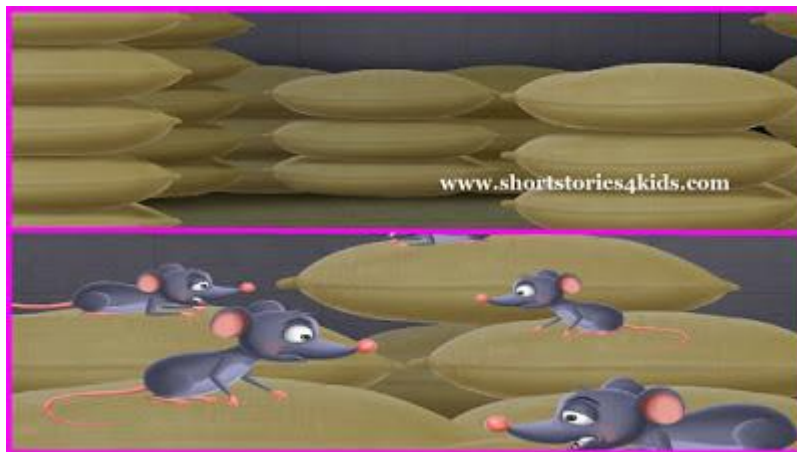


Belling the Cat - Short Story for Kids
